We are starting to offer Security and CCTV systems on a limited basis. We're also looking into products that allow for remote viewing and control of these systems through the internet.

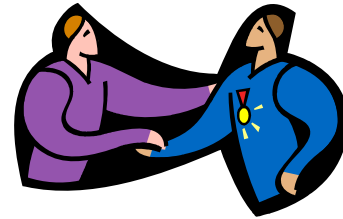

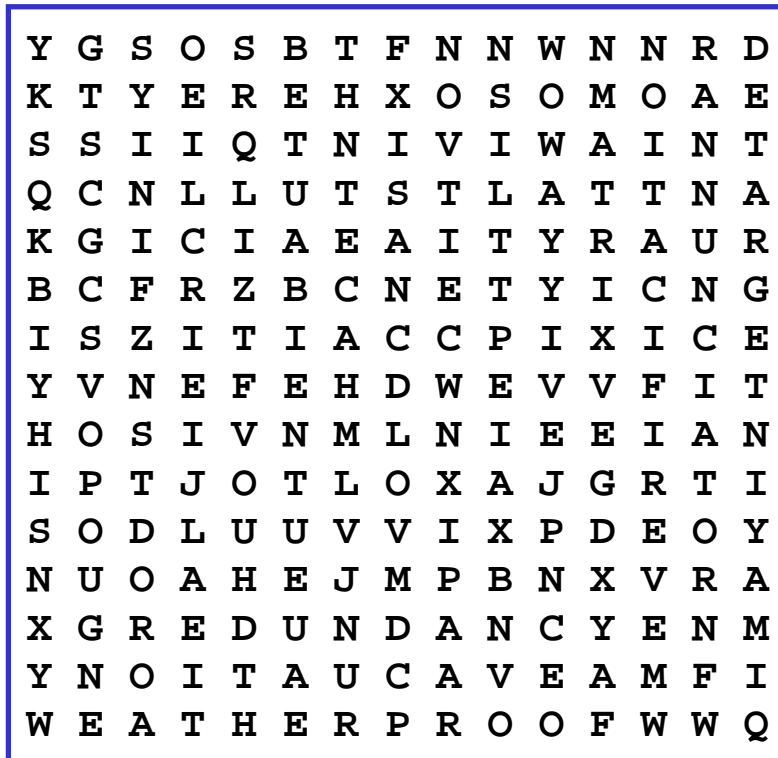

SIGA2 Line of Detectors

EST has released the SIGA2 line of Intelligent Life Safety Detectors. The new SIGA2-PCOS detectors have given Briscoe and EST an advantage in the industry with its Photoelectric and Carbon Monoxide Combination Detector that can be installed on the Signature Data Circuit without additional power required. The SIGA2-PCOS only uses 1 address and reports 2 separate events.

Other SIGA2 Detectors include: *SIGA2-PS, SIGA2-HFS, SIGA2-HRS, SIGA2-HCOS, and the SIGA2-COS*

SIGA2 Combination Detectors can only be installed on EST3 Systems with a 3-CPU3, an SSDC-1 or SDDC-1, and using the latest Version of 3-SDU (V4.01). All other SIGA2 Detectors can be installed on the EST2 System immediately. The iO will have SIGA2 compatibility within the year.

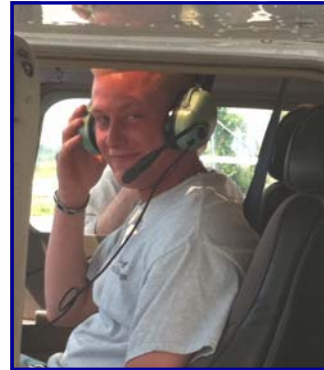
