Just One Life Program Launched to Save Lives through Smoke Detector Distribution Program

Leading Fire and Security Alarm Company Teams Up with Fire Departments to Provide Families with Life-Saving Devices in Light of Recent Home Fires in Suffolk County

There has been a rash of house fires on Long Island in the past month, some of which has resulted in the loss of life.

With the winter season approaching, more fires are expected to occur. The NFPA says that home fires and fire-related deaths occur the most often between December and February. Many residents use portable heaters to keep warm, but a fire may occur from the heaters being plugged in for too long or knocked over onto flammable materials or surfaces. Only cooking equipment causes more fires and fire-related deaths than heating equipment, according to the NFPA.
