

Summer Safety Tips

- Fuels for lawn and garden equipment should be stored in approved containers ONLY.
- July is peak month for grill fires - The grill should be placed well away from the home, deck railings and out from under eaves and overhanging branches.
- Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grills and in trays below the grill.
- Always make sure your gas grill lid is open before lighting it.
- Place all ashes from charcoal grills AND/OR fire pits in metal containers.
- Never burn yard waste or trash; It is both dangerous and illegal.
- Fireworks cause thousands of burns and eye injuries each year. Keep a close eye on children at events where fireworks are used. Even sparklers burn hot enough to cause third-degree burns.
- Don't forget to check your fire extinguishers and have them re-charged if necessary.
